

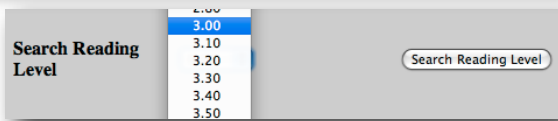
Lit2Go is a free online collection of stories and poems in Mp3 (audiobook) format. You can:

- Download the files to your Mp3 player and listen on the go,
- Listen to the Mp3 files on your computer,
- View the text on a webpage and read along as you listen,
- Print out the stories and poems to make your own book.

For Lit2Go, you may want download one or two stories each week, or you may want to download a lot at once. First are instructions for downloading one or two.

There are four ways to get started with Lit2Go:

1. **Browse by Author.** You can pick your stories by the author's last name.
2. **Browse by Title.** You can pick your stories by title.
3. **Search Database.** You can search the collection by title, author, keywords or reading level.
(a) An abstract, citation, playing time, and word count are given for each of the passages. Many of the passages also have a related reading strategy identified. Each reading passage can also be downloaded as a PDF and printed for use as a read-along or as supplemental reading material for your classroom.
4. **Launch iTunes.** If you have iTunes software installed on your computer, you can download many of the selections directly into your iTunes library. The free [iTunes application](#) for either Macintosh or Windows computers may be downloaded directly from Apple, Inc.



The **Search Database** allows you to search by reading level using the Flesch-Kincaid Grade Level score.

1. Click on **Search Database (a)**
2. Choose a reading level (Note 3.10 finds different results than 3.00 and you must do them separately.)
3. The recordings are separated by passage, which might be a chapter in a book, a poem in a book, or a story in a collection.
4. Click on a result that you are interested in **(b)**.
5. You now see info for that book.
6. Click on **View text in a webpage (c)** to see the content - to see if that story is good for your needs.

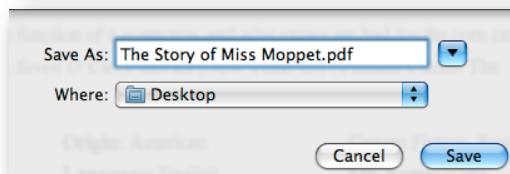
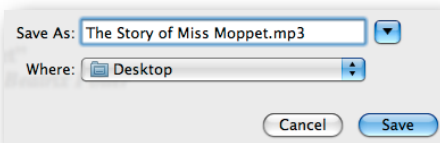
7. Highlight the title **(d)** of the story (not the quotes) and copy (⌘-C).
8. Right-click (control-click) on **Download PDF (e)**.
9. Choose **Download Linked File As**



10. Delete the current name **(f)** and paste (⌘-V) the title that you copied.
11. Click Save.
12. Download the MP3 the same way**.
13. If there is Support Material, you may want to download it as well.
14. Once you have it all downloaded, double click on that MP3 file **(g)**, it will open



15. When you are ready to use the MP3 file, add it to the appropriate synced playlist.



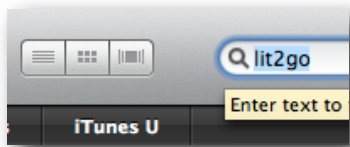
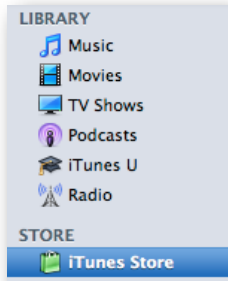
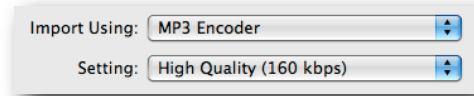

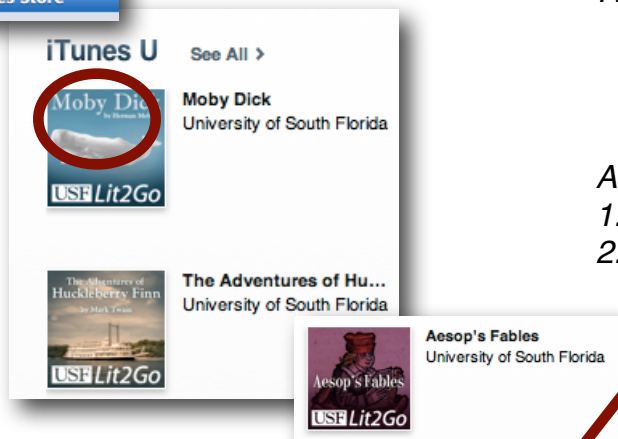
**NOTE: You don't actually need to change the name for the MP3 file - iTunes knows its name - but you may want have it's name if you want to share the file with other teachers.

For downloading large collections of mp3 files, iTunes is easier to use.

1. Choose **iTunes > Preferences**. Click on **General**. Click on **Import Settings**. Change **Import Using** to **MP3 Encoder** (change it back to your regular setting when you are done importing). Click OK. Then OK.
2. Choose iTunes Store



3. In the Search box, type lit2go, press return
4. Click on See All
5. Click on the collection you want
6. Click on **Get Tracks** to download all of the tracks OR click on Get next to the track you want.
7. The PDFs still must come from the Lit2Go website, not iTunes, but in both cases the lyrics are embedded in the metadata of the mp3 and show up in the iPod



Another way to find the titles is to

1. *click on **iTunes U** at the top menu bar*
2. *Click on **iTunes U Power Search***
